- To describe movement using left, right, near, far, a straight line and a quarter, half and three-quarter turns (clockwise and anti-clockwise).

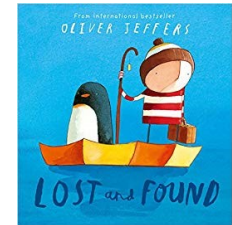
